*creaking as the rigging responds to the ocean's motion. The poet J. Ringelnatz perhaps said it best: "It roars like freedom..."*

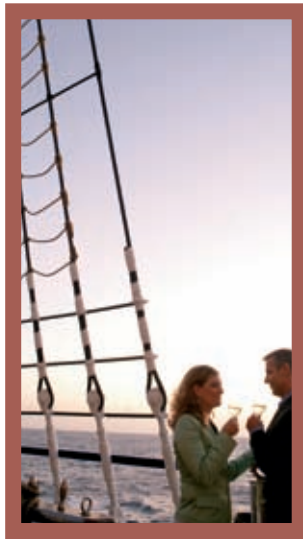






## Ancient seafarers told how the ocean soothes the soul.

*into the sea. Come gather with your fellow guests astern in the Lido Bar for a sundowner. Toast the breathtaking beauty of nature's display.*

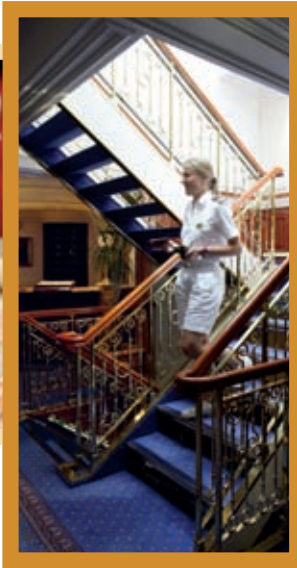

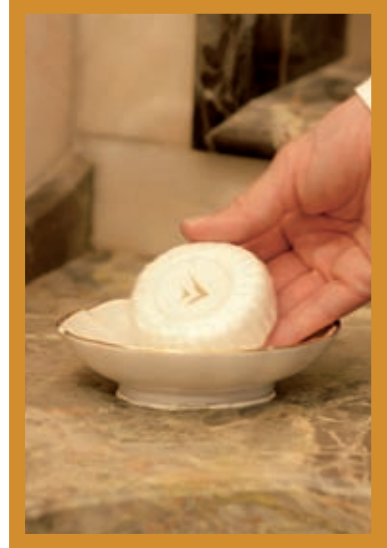

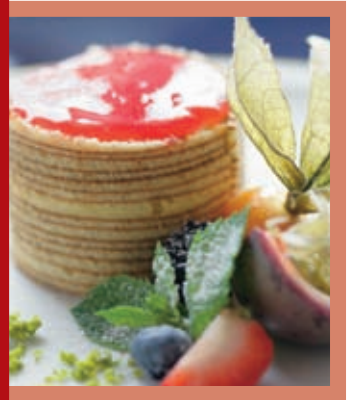

*time regions. And for passengers traveling there on the SEA CLOUD II, the experience is even more romantic, idyllic, and breathtaking.*

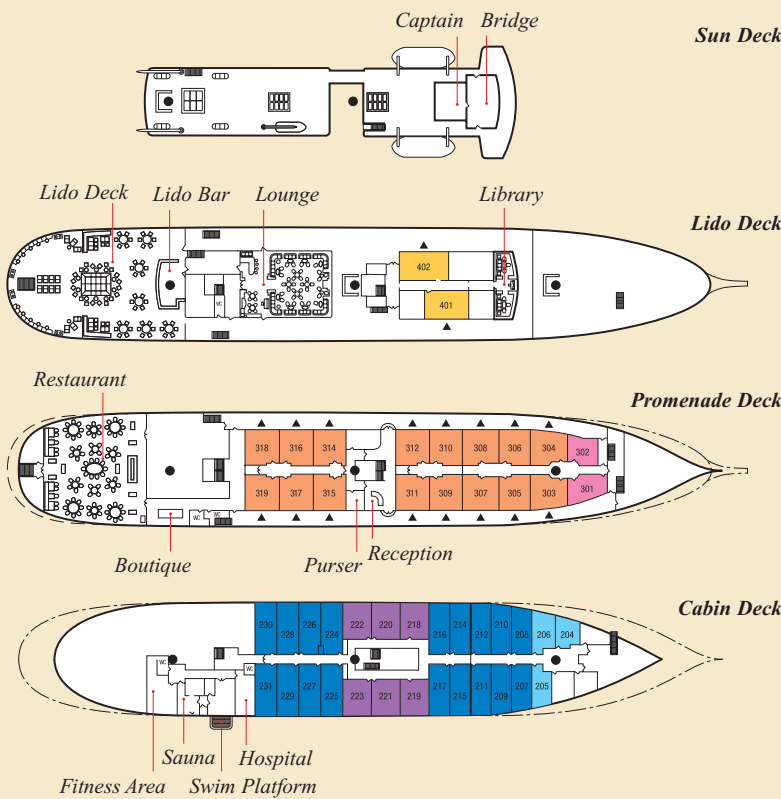

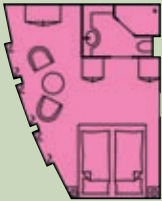
## Owner's Suites No. 401, 402 (Cat. A)

The two 290-square-foot Owner's Suites located on the Lido Deck feature panorama windows, a fireplace, a canopied king bed, four closets, TV with VCR, a minibar, and a safe. Spacious marble bathrooms are outfitted with a bathtub, a shower, and a sink.



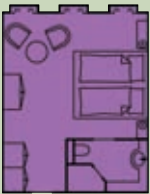
## Junior Suites No. 303-319 (Cat. B)

Junior Suites on the Promenade Deck are 247 squarefeet and feature panorama windows, a queen bed, a fireplace, a separate seating area, a walk-in closet, TV with VCR, a minibar, and a safe. Marble bathrooms have a tub with shower, and a marble sink



## Deluxe Outer Cabins No. 301 and 302 (Cat. C)

Two 204-square-foot Deluxe Outer Cabins at the bow of the ship on the Promenade Deck feature panorama windows, a queen bed with two separate mattresses, a separate seating area, a closet, TV with video, a minibar, and a safe. The 32-square-foot marble bathrooms have a shower, and a marble sink.



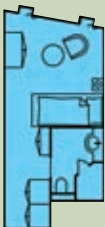
## Deluxe Outer Cabins No. 218-223 (Cat. D)

Six Deluxe Outer Cabins, at 204 square feet, are located midship on the Cabin Deck. They have portholes, a queen bed, a seating area, a closet, TV with VCR, a minibar, and a safe. The 32-square-foot bathrooms feature a shower, and a marble sink.



## Deluxe Outer Cabins No. 207-217 and 224-231 (Cat. E)

The 172-square-foot Deluxe Outer Cabins with portholes include a queen bed with two separate mattresses, a seating area, a closet, TV with VCR, a minibar, and a safe. The 32-square-foot bathrooms are equipped with a shower, and a marble sink.



## Outer Cabins No. 204-206 (Cat. F)

These 129-square-foot cabins have upper and lower single beds and are especially suited for those traveling alone. They have a small seating area, a closet, TV with VCR, a minibar, and a safe. The 32-square-foot bath has a shower, and a marble sink.
